The 49kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? Mcp 10 and Mcp 9 (GeneID 545055) are almost identical in their protein sequence. No cross-reactivity expected with the similar Mcp4. ELISA.; ELISA
