Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: ELISA; ELISA. Preliminary experiments gave an approx 38kDa band in Human Placenta, Lymph Node, and Tonsil lysates and in lysates of cell lines Daudi, Jurkat and MOLT4 after 0.5µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 93.5kDa according to NP_003234.2. The 38kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported?
