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Description: A server-based software wiki package written in PHP. It is a powerful, scalable software designed for high-traffic websites. MediaWiki uses PHP to process and display data stored in a database such as MySQL. When a user submits an edit to a page, MediaWiki writes it to the database without deleting the previous versions, allowing easy reversions. MediaWiki is able to manage image and multimedia files, as well, which are stored in the filesystem.
