Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested nT1[qls51] aneuploids, and non-GFP ok3636 homozygotes (sterile). Homozygous nT1[qls51] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: ATGCAAACATGCTCCAATGA. External right primer: ATTATCCGATCTGGCAGGTG. Internal left primer: AACAAACGACACTCCGATTTC. Internal right primer: ATCTCGTTTTCGCCCTCTGT. Internal WT amplicon: 1333 bp. Deletion size: 333 bp. Deletion left flank: GAATGATTAGATTTCTAGCGTAATGTTCAC.
