Notes: F20G4.1. Homozygous lethal deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok2423 homozygotes (early larval arrest). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: TCCAACCAATCCAGCTTTTC. External right primer: CCAAACGAGAAGACGGAGA. Internal left primer: TTCGACTTTTTTCGGCGAT. Internal right primer: ATGGAACATCCTGATGCTGA. Internal WT amplicon: 1173 bp. Deletion size: 637 bp. Deletion left flank: TTCTAAAAATAATTAAATTAGAGTGTTAAA.
