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Description: The Department of Pharmacology offers programs leading to the Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy degrees. The primary objective of these programs is to prepare candidates for research and teaching careers. The first few semesters are devoted primarily to core course work designed to give the student a broad background in the fundamental theories and techniques of pharmacology. During this time, the student gains exposure to methods for the solution of research problems by working in the laboratories of various faculty members culminating in a selection of a thesis advisor. The department has spacious laboratories equipped with modern instruments that are used by both faculty and students in such research areas as biochemical, molecular, cardiovascular, autonomic, clinical, and neuropharmacology, drug metabolism, cancer research and toxicology.
