The web site is designed to inform the public of the research activities conducted by the Hepatitis B Research Network. It is also a portal to support communications for their researchers and participants in their studies. The Hepatitis B Research Network is currently seeking patients for a multi-center prospective study of the natural history of chronic hepatitis B. Within the next few months treatment trials for various patients with chronic hepatitis B will also begin enrolling patients. Details of the entry criteria for these studies can be obtained from the clinical centers outlined on the website's map.
