Comments: This plasmid uses the T7lac promoter to express in *E. coli* the mature (lacking the signal peptide), wild-type protein containing an N-terminal PelB signal peptide + His10 + mature maltose binding protein + TEV protease cleavage site. The gene encoding the protein does not have the same DNA sequence as *B. burgdorferi* because the gene has been optimized for expression in *E. coli*. RevA is a lipoprotein. RevA is not expected to be lipidated in this construct. Following TEV cleavage, RevA lacks 5 residues (CKAYV) at the N-terminus of the mature protein.
