Comments: Ligase used in efficiently joining single-strand breaks in a double-strand polydeoxynucleotide in an ATP-dependent reaction. Also involved in DNA non-homologous end joining (NHEJ) required for double-strand break repair and V(D)J recombination. The plasmids in the Open Enzyme collection contain genetic parts and are not functional by themselves. Researchers can clone these enzymes into an expression vector of their choice and then transform into E. coli bacteria for expression and purification.
