Comments: DNA polymerase used in (routine) PCR method because of its high thermostability, standard testing, screening and output testing. Has a relatively high error rate because it lacks 3'-5' exonuclease activity and proofreading functionality. 5'-3' flap endonuclease degrades displaced strand. The plasmids in the Open Enzyme collection contain genetic parts and are not functional by themselves. Researchers can clone these enzymes into an expression vector of their choice and then transform into E. coli bacteria for expression and purification.
