Comments: DNA ligase that seals nicks in double-stranded DNA during DNA replication, DNA recombination and DNA repair. Catalyzes template-dependent ligation at temperatures of about 30-80 degrees C, and substantially retains its catalytic activity when subjected to temperatures of about 85 degrees C to about 100 degrees C. The plasmids in the Open Enzyme collection contain genetic parts and are not functional by themselves. Researchers can clone these enzymes into an expression vector of their choice and then transform into E. coli bacteria for expression and purification.
