Notes: C38H2.2. Homozygous sterile deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok2175 homozygotes (sterile, lays no eggs). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: ATGTGCTGGTGATATGGCAA. External right primer: GAAAAGGCACAGGGTGTGAT. Internal left primer: TCAGACAACCTACGACGCTG. Internal right primer: AGGGTGGAGAACAGTCATGG. Internal WT amplicon: 2946 bp. Deletion size: 767 bp. Deletion left flank: GCGAAGAAGGTTTCGCGTCTTCTGTTGGATT.
