Notes: R05H5.4. Homozygous sterile deletion chromosome balanced by GFP- and dpy-10-marked inversion. Heterozygotes are WT with relatively dim pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT dim GFP, Dpy bright GFP (mIn1 homozygotes), and non-GFP ok2875 homozygotes (sterile, no eggs). Pick WT dim GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: TCTCCACCAACGTAACACCA. External right primer: ACTCTTCTTGGCAGTGCGAT. Internal left primer: ATTCGGATCCACAGACTTCG. Internal right primer: AAGAGAACAAGCAAGACGGC. Internal WT amplicon: 1173 bp. Deletion size: 616 bp. Deletion left flank: ACATTCCAAAGTCAGCCATCTTGACGACTC. Deletion right flank: AGAAGTTTTTCCACCGATCTTCGCCGTCTT.
