Used to predict undistorted data, to which actual observed images can be aligned, to estimate and to correct for volume-to-volume movement and off-resonance fields, to signal dropout caused by movement during diffusion encoding, within-volume movement and movement-induced changes of susceptibility-induced off-resonance field. In addition to correcting for these effects, the output from this framework offers description of off resonance and subject movement effects present in uncorrected data.
